Subject: SPECIAL ALERT: Federal Reserve Webinar - Paycheck Protection Program

Earlier this week the Federal Reserve announced that it would **establish a facility to facilitate lending to small businesses** via the SBA's PPP. To answer questions surrounding the PPP and the facility, the Fed is hosting a webinar on Friday, April 10, 2020.

Senior officials from the **Federal Reserve will be hosting the webinar this coming Friday** to review the details of this lending facility and answer questions. The session will feature senior officials from both the Board of Governors (Monetary Affairs Division and Legal Divisions) and Federal Reserve Banks.
